Health and Safety Update and Review

- Dr Hooks noted the school is required to follow DCPS notifications and protocols; they are not originated at the school level. Continue to ensure comprehensive communications in the school newsletter.
- LSAT agreed the school year had started remarkably well with health and safety being well maintained.

Enrollment Update

- The school's budget is tied to student enrollment. For a variety of reasons (pandemic/virtual options, international students, private school alternatives), registration of actual students (375) was lower than projected enrollment (404).
- Discussion on budget impact, as well as future planning for lack of classroom space and growing grade levels (particularly at 5th grade).
- DCPS will require a decision soon on proposed ECE programming shifts. This decision will have implications for a number of classes at other grade levels.
